



IMPORTANT NOTICE

REGULATION TO IMPLEMENT THE PRIORITY TURNS SYSTEM AND EXPRESS LINE FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES OR FOR PERSONS SIXTY (60) YEARS OLD OR MORE AND PREGNANT WOMEN WHO REQUEST THE SERVICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND HUMAN RESOURCES

The Department of Labor and Human Resources, according to the faculties and powers conferred by the Law No. 15 of April 14, 1931, as amended, known as the "Organic Act of the Department of Labor and Human Resources", and by virtue of the Law No. 51 of July 4, 2001, as amended, known as "Law to establish the agencies and public corporations of the Government of Puerto Rico the obligation to create a system of express line"; the Law No. 354 of September 2, 2000, known as "Law to order the agencies of the Government of Puerto Rico, the municipalities, and private entities that receives public funds to confer Priority Turns to People with Disabilities; the Law 107 of July 3, 1998, as amended; the Law 108 of July 12, 1985, as amended, and Law No. 170 of August 12, 1988, as amended, known as "Uniform Administrative Procedures Act", promulgates the "Regulation to Implement the Priority Turns System and Express Line for Persons with Disabilities, Persons Sixty Years Old or more and Pregnant Women who Request the Services of The Department of Labor and Human Resources in any of its instrumentalities.

The purpose of this regulation is to establish an Express Line and to confer Priority Turns to persons with disabilities or to persons sixty years old or more and pregnant women.
