IMPORTANT NOTICE

REGULATION FOR SECURITY AND FOR THE INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF ELECTRONIC SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM IN THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND HUMAN RESOURCES

The Department of Labor and Human Resources, pursuant to the faculties and powers conferred to Law No. 15 of April 14, 1931, as amended, known as the "Organic Act of the Department of Labor and Human Resources", and by virtue of Law No.46 of April 29, 2008 known as "Public Buildings Security Act of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico" and Law No. 170 of August 12, 1988, as amended, known as "Uniform Administrative Procedures Act", promulgates the Regulation for Security and for the Installation and Operation of Electronic Surveillance System in the Department of Labor and Human Resources.

The purpose of this regulation is to establish minimum standards to guarantee the security of the visitors and public employees, as well as to protect the integrity of public property by means of the use of electronic video surveillance. This regulation also aspires to regulate in a civilized manner the form in which our citizens gain physical access to the public buildings and to prevent or reduce the likelihood of occurrences of illegal acts.
